In Mendoza, 1000 km away from Buenos Aires, with good wine and beautiful mountains, 20 married couples have participated in a "Married Love" course. The local promoters have already announced three more courses before the end of the year. In the second semester there will be a PIMOF to train local moderators so they don't need facilitators from the Capital.

In May they plan to start other courses in Misiones (near the Oguazú waterfalls) with 20 married couples more. This is the way all the Argentinian geography will be "taken over" by Family Enrichment. The great "pending subject" is to continue training moderators who can take the lead in the different regions so the pioneer moderators don't have to travel up, down and sideways the big country of Argentina; thus they all do it with very high spirit.
